

ORDINANCE NO. 318

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING SCHOOL CROSSWALKS, CROSSWALK LINES, AND AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF CROSSWALK, PEDESTRIAN, NO PARKING, AND STOP SIGNS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.

Section 1. That painted school crosswalks shall be placed at the following intersections:

One painted crosswalk at 156th and Klamm Street;  
One painted crosswalk at 156th Terrace and Klamm Street;  
One painted crosswalk at 157th and Klamm Street

Section 2. That crosswalk and pedestrian sign(s) concerning the above shall be erected in accordance with the requirements of the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices as adopted by the City of Basehor.

Section 3. That stop sign(s) shall be erected in the vicinity of 156th Terrace and Klamm Street.

Section 4. That No Parking Sign[s] shall be erected on the north side of Klamm Street from 156th Street to 157th Street which shall prohibit parking on the north side of Klamm Street during the hours of 8:45 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. and during the hours of 3:45 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. Said prohibition shall only apply during school days.


Section 5. That all signs and the placement of said signs authorized by this Ordinance shall be in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices as adopted by the City of Basehor.

Section 6. That violations of this Ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided in the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas City as adopted by the City of Basehor, Kansas.

Section 7. That this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.


