

ORDINANCE # 151
An ordinance amending the date of election in ordinance number 150 and changing the language in the ballot form and setting a

CITY WIDE RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-HALF OF ONE-PERCENT (0.5%) AND DIRECTING SUBMISSION OF QUESTION TO ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby levied a city wide retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-half of one-percent (0.5%).

Section 2. Such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom, to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the State Department of Revenue relating to the retailers' sales tax shall apply to such local sales tax insofar as such levy and regulations may be made applicable.

Section 3. The services of the State Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax as provided by law.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be effective on May 1, 1982, and after publication as provided by law subject to approval by a majority of the electors of the City of Basehor, Kansas, of the following question, to-wit:

"Should the City of Basehor, Kansas ~~impose~~ the one-half of one-percent (0.5%) local sales tax, enacted by Ordinance 151."

said question to be submitted to the electors on April 20, 1982, in accordance with the laws of the State of Kansas applicable to a questions submitted election.
