BASEHOR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

July 25, 2005

**Official Presiding: Mayor Chris Garcia**

**Members Present: Pres. John Bonee, Iris Dysart, Bill Hooker, Keith Sifford, and Terry Thomas (arrived at 6:15 p.m.)**

**Staff Present: Mary Mogle, Sgt. Martin Cigich**

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Mayor Garcia called the work session to order with all members present with the exception of Councilmember Thomas (who arrived at 6:15 p.m.). The mayor read aloud the purpose of the work session and the Request for Special Meeting form.

**WORK SESSION**

*Item #1.*

*Joint meeting with HNTB Corporation to discuss local street network in order to determine future roadway types, number of lanes, right-of-way widths and how the interchanges will work with the local road improvements. (They will eventually be presenting the information gathered from our meetings with each community at the Advisory Council Meeting later in August and the Public Meeting in September.)*

HNTB representatives presented a map showing the planned K-7 corridor and provided a copy of a traffic study. Council discussed options to the plan. HNTB asked the governing body to review the plan and give feedback. Council agreed to meet again at the August 8<sup>th</sup> work session.

Work session adjourned at 7:10 p.m.

Mayor Garcia called a five-minute break.

**SPECIAL MEETING**

The Special Meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m. with all members present.

Mayor Garcia reported the department supervisors met last week and made their own departmental budget cuts in order to reduce the mill levy from 39 mills to 29.683 as presented. The city treasurer explained the projects that were eliminated, to include a reduction in the city administrator's salary, and elimination of the \$5000 in the governing body budget. By amending the originally submitted budget, the mill levy was reduced to 29.683. This was an increase of 1.25 mills over the 2005 budget.

President Bonee stated he was not in favor of increasing the mill levy in 2006 and thought more expenditures could be cut. Mayor Garcia felt at some point and time the City should plan for infrastructure. President Bonee stated he wanted to see the funds collected for building permits and parkland fees go toward roads and the City start prioritizing projects.

A motion was made by President Bonee and seconded by Councilmember Dysart to approve the budget at 28.437 mills for year 2006. Discussion followed.

Councilmember Thomas asked how much the 1.25 mills added up to in dollars. The city clerk requested a brief recess to give the city treasurer some time to calculate the tax.

A motion was made by President Bonee and seconded by Councilmember Sifford to leave the previous motion on the table and recess for ten minutes in order to give the city treasure time to research Councilmember Thomas's request. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0.

The city treasurer returned reporting the 1.25 mills calculated to a little over \$36,000.

Mayor Garcia called for the vote. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0.

Council agreed the additional \$36,000+ should be taken from the general fund rather than the Bond & Interest fund.

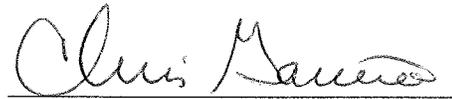
**Item #2. Authorize the city clerk to publish 2006 Budget Notice of

A motion was made by Councilmember Hooker and seconded by President Bonee to authorize the city clerk to publish the 2006 Budget Public Hearing notice (with a mill levy rate of 28.437) for August 15, 2005 at 6:00 p.m.

**ADJOURNMENT**

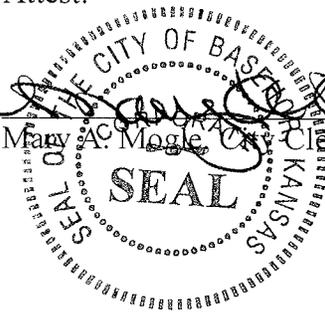
