
Mayor Pfannenstiel announced the purpose of the special meeting was to decide if the city council wanted to challenge the county's decision to hold a primary election and overrule the city's home rule power as stated in Charter Ordinance No. 1.

City attorney, John Thompson, reported this was a serious issue noting the county should not have the power to supercede the city's local powers. He urged the board to seek a declaratory judgement in district court rather than allowing the county to make that decision on their own.


