

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 7

A CHARTER ORDINANCE CHANGING THE CITY COUNCIL'S RULES OF ORDER CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF A QUORUM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the City of Basehor, through its council members, conducts its business in accordance with adopted rules of order.

Section 2. That the current rules of order require that at all city meetings there must be a quorum present in order to transact business. A quorum is a majority of a full member of council members which the city is suppose to have regardless of whether there is a vacancy existing at the time.

Section 3. That under the present rules of order a quorum is obtained if there are three (3) of the city council members present at the city meeting.

Section 4. From the date of this Ordinance, a quorum shall require four (4) of the city council members to be present in order to transact city business.

Section 5. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city paper.
