**CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 13
Court Costs**

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF BASEHOR FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. Supp. 12-4112 AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT AUTHORIZING THE ASSESSMENT OF COURT COSTS FOR CASES HEARD IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS.

Section 1. The City of Basehor, a city of the 3rd class, by virtue of the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas hereby elects to exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. Suppl. 12-4112, which is not uniformly applicable to all cities. The legislature having made special provisions applying to certain classes of the city in said enactment.

Section 2. In lieu of the provisions of K.S.A. Supp. 12-4112 the governing body of the City of Basehor hereby adopts the following provisions:

"Every person entering a plea of guilty, no contest, found guilty or receives a diversion or amendment for any violation of the ordinances of the City of Basehor shall be assessed costs for the administration of justice in the municipal court of the City of Basehor in an amount as set by ordinance."

Section 3. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 4. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after its final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subsection)(3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 16th day of December, 2002.


