CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 17

A CHARTER ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS
REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 15 OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the city of Basehor, Kansas (the "City"), pursuant to Article 12, § 5 of the Kansas Constitution has previously adopted Charter Ordinance No. 15 establishing a sewer hook on fee for the 24/40 Sanitary Sewer project; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it advisable to repeal Charter Ordinance No. 15, as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repealer. Charter Ordinance No. 15 of the City, passed and approved on January 31, 2005, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after its final publication unless a petition signed by not less than 10% of the electors who voted at the last preceding regular City election is filed with the City Clerk requiring a referendum to be held on this Charter Ordinance as provided in Article 12, § 5 (c)(3) of the Kansas Constitution, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon. Upon its effective date this Charter Ordinance shall be recorded by the City Clerk in a book maintained for charter ordinances of the City and shall be filed with the Secretary of State of the state of Kansas.
