CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 23

**A CHARTER ORDINANCE REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE 7 PERTAINING TO THE NUMBER OF COUNCILMEMBERS NEEDED TO CONSTITUTE A QUORUM TO CONDUCT BUSINESS**

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to the provisions of Article 12, Section 5, of the constitution of the State of Kansas, the City of Basehor, Kansas does hereby repeal Charter Ordinance 7, which Ordinance requires that four of the five council members be present to conduct business. Once this Ordinance becomes effective, the City will abide by the statutory requirement of having three council members present at any meeting to conduct business.

**SECTION 2.** This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

**SECTION 3.** This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

ADOPTED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, BY NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR OF BASEHOR, KANSAS ON THE 18 DAY OF AUGUST, 2008.

Once this Ordinance becomes effective, the City will abide by the statutory requirement of having three council members present at any meeting to conduct business.

That this weekly newspaper printed in the State of Kansas, and published in and of general circulation in Leavenworth County, Kansas, with a general paid circulation on a weekly basis in Leavenworth County, Kansas, and that said newspaper is not a trade, religious or fraternal publication, and which newspaper has been admitted to the mails as periodicals class matter in said County, and that a notice of which is hereto attached, was published in the regular and entire issue of the Basehor Sentinel

**SECTION 2.** This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

**SECTION 3.** This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Said newspaper is published weekly 52 weeks a year; has been so published continuously and uninterruptedly in said county and state for a period of more than one year prior to the first publication of said notice and been admitted at the post office of Basehor in said County as second class matter.

ADOPTED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, BY NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR OF BASEHOR, KANSAS, ON THE 18th DAY OF AUGUST, 2008.


