1. City's responsibility for repayment of EPA funds after termination of sewer program.
2. Payment of Martell's bill submitted and voted upon at the July meeting. Actually, vote was for authorization of submission to EPA of 757.00 of that bill and for payment from City Treasury of 257.00 of that bill. Under Kansas statutes; If the mayor would not sign the authorization or sign the voucher, the President of the City Council would be empowered to sign instead. Since Mr. Eberth said he would sign the authorization and voucher, no vote was necessary.
3. Possibility of issuing general obligation bonds up to 100,000.00 without a required vote of the people. Would discuss the matter with the City's bonding agent.

CITY ENGINEER

Discussed whether Martell should continue on an ad lib basis or whether he should be appointed City Engineer. Martell stated that he had agreed to research and report on the building of a smaller third cell and aeration. There was further discussion of what was necessary for the immediate needs.

Motion - That Martell request a cost estimate from a contractor on the sewer project, as long as there were no city funds committed to it - passed 3 to 2.

Waters- The bonding company would require another city election.
