SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL MEETING

THOSE PRESENT: ANNA MARY LANDAUER, LOREN WILKES, BOB VAN CLEAVE, MARK GRUBE

OTHERS PRESENT: DOUG WATERS/CITY ATTORNEY, BRUCE BROWNE/CITY ENGINEER, CAROL HUBBEL/CITY CLERK AND CITIZENS OF BASEHOR.

PRESIDING OFFICER: MAYOR TUTER

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:45 P.M.

BRUCE BROWNE'S CONTRACT

DOUG WATERS STATED THAT THE CONTRACT WAS FINE EXCEPT FOR THE MIDDLE PARAGRAPH ON PAGE 8. THE REVISION IS AS FOLLOWS: THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO SUCH MODIFICATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS SO AS TO COMPLY WITH ALL THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE KANSAS CASH BASIS LAW. (K.S.A. 10-1101 et seq.) MOVED BY MARK GRUBE THAT THE CONTRACT BE ACCEPTED WITH THE REVISION AS STATED BY DOUG WATERS. SECONDED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

A LETTER FROM THE CITY OF BASEHOR IS TO BE SENT TO FRANK BASER, THE DEPT. OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT, STATING: 1. THE REASON WHY THE CITY TERMINATED THE CONTRACT WITH MARTELL. 2.. WHY THE CITY CHANGED ITS PLANS. 3. THE DIRECTION WE ARE GOING NOW. MOVED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER THAT THE LETTER BE SENT TO BASER. SECONDED BY LOREN WILKES. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

TWO NEW ORDINANCES WERE READ TO THE COUNCIL FOR THEIR APPROVAL. THEY ARE AS FOLLOWS: AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS, AND THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM: AND PROVIDING FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF: IN THE CITY OF BASEHOR, COUNTY OF LEAVENWORTH, STATE OF KANSAS, AND AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A USER CHARGE SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF BASEHOR, COUNTY OF LEAVENWORTH, STATE OF KANSAS, TO PROVIDE FUNDS NEEDED TO PAY ALL EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CITY'S WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS. MOVED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER THAT THE CITY ACCEPT THE ABOVE ORDINANCES. SECONDED BY LOREN WILKES. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

THE CITY CLERK IS TO SIGN THE PLANT MODIFICATIONS WHICH ARE MARTELL'S PLANS WITH BRUCE BROWNE'S DELETIONS. MOVED BY LOREN WILKES TO ACCEPT TREATMENT PLANT MODIFICATIONS. SECONDED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

BOB VAN CLEAVE STATED CITY TREASURER, JANE SCHERER, REQUESTED OVERTIME PAY FOR WORK DONE ON THE PAYROLL BOOK FOR YEAR END TOTALS. BOB VAN CLEAVE MOVED THAT JANE SCHERER BE PAID FOR THE OVERTIME WORK UP TO \$100.00. SECONDED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

HOFFMAN'S MOBILE HOME PERMIT

COUNCIL DIDN'T APPROVED BECAUSE THE APPLICATION WASN'T FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AND A NOTE FROM A DOCTOR IS NECESSARY TO BE APPROVED.

HODGES MOBILE HOME PERMIT

DOUG WATERS SAID THAT HE WAS GOING TO PROCEED WITH PROSECUTION WHICH CONSIST OF A SUPOENA MR. HODGES TO APPEAR AT THE NEXT COURT SESSION FOR ARRAIGNMENT AND THAT ANY

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COMPLAINTS THE CITIZENS MIGHT HAVE AGAINST MR. HODGES SHOULD BE PRESENT AT THAT TIME.
