I ALSO WISH TO STATE THAT I WAS IN NO WAY RESPONSIBLE FOR CHANGING THE MINUTES NOR WAS I CONSULTED AS TO THEIR ACCURACY.

I WAS ADVISED TO MAKE A PUBLIC STATEMENT AT THE COUNCIL MEETING, BUT THIS WAY IS JUST AS EFFECTIVE AND MIGHT SAVE THE CITY ANY EMBARRASSMENT.
