SUBJECT CITY COUNCIL MEETING

THOSE PRESENT: ANNA MARY LANDAUER, LORAN WILKES, BOB VAN CLEAVE, JOHN NOVAK, MARK GRUBE.

MINUTES

MOVED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER, SECONDED BY LORAN WILKES TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

TREASURER'S REPORT

MOVED BY MARK GRUBE SECONDED BY JOHN NOVAK TO APPROVE THE TREASURER'S REPORT. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

PETITIONS/CITIZENS

DAN SCHWARTZE/KENNEL LICENSE

MR. SCHWARTZE REQUESTED THE CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE A KENNEL LICENSE AT 15637 LV. RD.

DON WILSON, ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER STATED HE HAD INSPECTED THE PREMISES AND MR. SCHWARTZE HAD COMPLETED THE NECESSARY REQUIREMENTS ACCORDING TO ORDINANCE # 15. THE ONLY PROBLEM HE COULD SEE WAS THE KENNEL WOULD BE WITHIN 750 TO 800' OF PARTIES THAT HAD COMPLAINED ABOUT BARKING DOGS.

DOUG WATERS STATED HE FELT THE PLANNING COMMISSION SHOULD REVIEW THE SITUATION AND THE COUNCIL SHOULD ACT UPON THEIR RECOMMENDATION.

ORDINANCE 156, AMENDING ORDINANCE # 155 TEMPORARY NOTES FOR STREET REPAIRS

MR. WATERS STATED THE ATTORNEY GENERAL HAD REJECTED THE ORIGINAL FORMAT USED AND REQUESTED A NEW ORDINANCE BE DRAWN UP DELETING REFERENCES TO K.S.A. 12-601 AND THE FOLLOWING STATUTES OF THE STATE OF KANSAS, THEREFORE ORDINANCE 156 IS AMENDING ORDINANCE 155 DELETING REFERENCES TO THE STATE STATUTES. 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ORDINANCE # 157 STANDARD TRAFFIC

MOVED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER, SECONDED BY LORAN WILKES TO HAVE THE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #157. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOVED BY JOHN NOVAK, SECONDED BY BOB VAN CLEAVE TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY AND WAIVE THE SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE # 157 AND TO ADOPT IT. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

RESOLUTION #20 COPIES OF CITY ORDINANCES

BOB VAN CLEAVE READ A PROPOSED RESOLUTION STATING WHEN ANY MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL'S TERM IS UP THEY MUST RETURN THEIR COPIES OF THE ORDINANCES OR BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF THEIR REPRODUCTION. MOVED BY LORAN WILKES, SECONDED BY BOB VAN CLEAVE TO APPROVE RESOLUTION # 20. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

MR. VAN CLEAVE ALSO STATED HE WOULD LIKE A CHECK ISSUED TONIGHT ONE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$178.34 TO McANNEY, VAN CLEAVE, AND PHILLIPS FOR MATERIALS USED AND THE SECOND ONE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50.00 TO RHONDA S. MILLER FOR HER TIME SPENT IN ORGANIZING AND COMPOSING THE DOCUMENTS. MOVED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER SECONDED BY MARK GRUBE TO ISSUE THE TWO CHECKS TONIGHT IN THE AMOUNTS STATED ABOVE. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.
