MINUTES

MOVED BY BOB VAN CLEAVE, SECONDED BY MARK GRUBE TO APPROVED THE MINUTES OF THE LAST

TREASURER'S REPORT

MOVED BY MARK GRUBE TO APPROVE THE TREASURER'S REPORT WITH THE EXCEPTION OF HOLDING
THE CHECK TO SCHERER TRUCK CO. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1785.00 UNTIL SOME CLARIFICATION COULD
BE MADE. SECONDED BY LORAN WILKES. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

PETITIONS/CITIZENS

GARRY EBERTH/COURT APPEAL

MR. EBERTH STATED WHEN HE APPEARED IN COURT AND WAS FOUND GUILTY OF SPEEDING, HE ASKED
ABOUT THE PROCEDURE TO APPEAL. HE SAID THE CITY ATTORNEY TOLD HIM IT WOULD COST \$40.00
TO APPEAL AND WIN OR LOSE THE \$40.00 WOULD BE FORFIETED. MR. WATERS REMARKED, HE DIDN'T
REMEMBER THE CONVERSATION AS SUCH, HOWEVER HE WOULD HAVE NO OBJECTIONS TO MR. EBERTH
APPEALING THE JUDGEMENT IF HE CHOSE TO DO SO. MR. EBERTH STATED HE DID WISH TO APPEAL. MR.
WATERS SAID HE WOULD NOTIFY THE COUNTY COURT OF THE MISUNDERSTANDING.

KAREN MARTAIN/SIDEWALKS FROM THE POST OFFICE TO THE HIGH SCHOOL

THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL RECEIVED A LETTER FROM MRS. MARTAIN EXPLAINING THE
SUPPORT SHE HAS FOR A SIDEWALK TO BE BUILT FROM THE POST OFFICE TO THE HIGH SCHOOL. MRS.
MARTAIN WAS NOT AT THE MEETING SO THE COUCIL WAS NOT ABLE TO DETERMINE JUST WHAT SHE WANT-
ED THE CITY TO DO. MARK GRUBE REMARKED THE SUGGESTION WAS A GOOD ONE, THE COUNCIL SHOULD
TAKE THE MATTER UNDER CONSIDERATION UNTIL MORE INFORMATION COULD BE AQUIRED.

ANNA MARY LANDAUER STATED MRS. BLANKENSHIP'S DRIVE WAS TORNED UP BY THE STREET CONSTRUCTION CREW AND WANTED TO KNOW WHAT THE CITY COULD DO ABOUT IT. ALSO SHE SAID THE MAILBOXES THAT WERE REMOVED, WERE THEY SUPPOSE TO HAVE BEEN PUT BACK BY THE STREET CREW. THE COUNCIL SUGGESTED SHE TALK WITH MR. BROWNE CONCERNING THESE ITEMS.
