MOVED BY ANNA MARY LANDUER, SECONDED BY LORAN WILKES TO APPOINT LLOYD BETH AS CHIEF OF POLICE. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

OFFICERS APPOINTED

THE CHIEF OF POLICE REQUESTED THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS BE REAPPOINTED: OFFICERS CHARLES JORDAN, MIKE WEBB, TERRY YETHBACHER, LELAND HUFF, AND CLIFFORD CECIL. MOVED BY MARK GRUBE SECONDED BY LORAN WILKES TO APPOINT THE OFFICERS. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

PETITIONS/REQUEST CITIZENS

GLORIA BATESEL PRESENTED A PETITION TO THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THEIR CONSIDERATION. THE PETITION HAD AN ESTIMATED 160 SIGNATURES ASKING FOR THE DISMISSAL OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE, LLOYD BETH, AND OFFICER BOB McCONNELL. MRS. BATESEL STATED IF THE COUNCIL DID NOT DO SOMETHING ABOUT IT SHE WOULD TAKE IT FURTHER.

MAYOR TUTER STATED HALF OF THE REQUEST HAD ALREADY BEEN TAKEN CARE OF AS OFFICER McCONNELL WAS NOT REAPPOINTED. HE REMARKED THE COUNCIL WOULD DISCUSS THE PETITION AND ASSURED MRS. BATESEL THE MATTER WOULD NOT GO UNATTENDED, HOWEVER A DECISION COULD NOT BE MADE TONIGHT.

JOHN NOVAK REQUESTED COPIES OF PETITION TO SEE IF ALL SIGNATURES WERE REGISTERED VOTERS.

SANDY DILLION/GATEWOOD

MRS. DILLION ASKED WHY JACK GATEWOOD WAS NOT REAPPOINTED AS POLICE OFFICER. MAYOR TUTER STATED " FOR MEDICAL REASON AT THE PRESENT TIME".

AMBROSE JENNING/WATER DRAINAGE

MR. JENNING WAS PRESENT TO DISCUSS IMPROPER WATER DRAINAGE ONTO HIS PROPERTY. MAYOR TUTER INVITED MR. JENNINGS TO ATTEND THE WORK SESSION AND HIS PROBLEM WOULD BE DISCUSSED THEN.

SANDY DILLION/GATEWOOD

MRS. DILLION ASKED THE MAYOR IF JACK GATEWOOD RECEIVED A DOCTOR'S RELEASE FORM THE DOCTOR WOULD HE THEN BE ABLE TO COME BACK TO WORK? MAYOR TUTER STATED THAT IT IS THE COUNCIL'S DECISION; MR. GATEWOOD IS NOT PRESENTLY QUALIFIED NOR PHYSICALLY ABLE TO BE ON THE JOB.

HE SUGGESTED THE CITY CONTACT THEM THROUGH THE CITY ATTORNEY GIVING THEM AN ALLOTTED TIME FRAME AND IF AT THAT TIME THE REPAIRS ARE NOT COMPLETED THE CITY COULD TAKE SUIT IF THAT IS WHAT THEY CHOSE TO DO. MOVED BY LORAN WILKES, SECONDED BY ANNA MARY LANDAUER FOR THE CITY ATTORNEY TO SEND HARBOUR BROTHERS A LETTER STATING THE TIME ALLOTTED FOR REPAIRS AND THE POSSIBILITY OF A LAW SUIT. ALL AYE. MRS. HUBBEL REQUESTED A 10% RAISE FOR THE CITY EMPLOYEES SINCE IT HAD BEEN 18 MONTHS SINCE THE LAST INCREASE. SOME DISCUSSION FOLLOWED AND IT WAS DECIDED TO TABLE THE DISCUSSION UNTIL THE WORK SESSION.

TRASH RATE INCREASE

MRS. HUBBEL REMINDED THE COUNCIL THE TRASH WOULD HAVE TO BE INCREASE IN ORDER FOR THE ACCOUNTS TO REMAIN SOLVENT. DISCUSSION FOLLOWED AND WAS DETERMINED THAT RATE INCREASE WOULD BE AS FOLLOWS: REGULAR TRASH PICK UP WILL CHANGE FROM 4.50 PER MONTH TO 5.00 PER MONTH. PRIVAT HAULERS PERMITS WILL GO FROM 10.00 PER MONTH TO 16.00 PER MONTH. THE PERSONS ON THE HOMESTEAD ACT WILL REMAIN THE SAME. MOVED BY BOB VAN CLEAVE, SECONDED BY LORAN WILKES TO APPROVE THE ABOVE RATE INCREASES FOR THE TRASH SERVICES. ALL AYE. MOTION CARRIED.

IT WAS REPORTED STREET REPAIRS WERE NEEDED AT 153rd TERR. AND 153rd ELM.

LLOYD BETH/CHIEF OF POLICE
