A Special Meeting of the Basehor City Council was called for the purpose of acting on the resolution of the City of Basehor authorizing and directing the issuance of a renewal temporary note, Series 1983, in the principal amount of \$66,500 for the purpose of providing funds to renew a temporary note, Series 1982-1, which was previously issued to pay the cost of certain sewer disposal improvements and transacting such further business as may come before said meeting.

Mr. Thompson introduced Mr. Steineger, Bond Attorney, who explained the details of the proposed temporary note. He explained that the \$84,500 note, plus interest for one year at the rate of \$7,182.50, totals \$91,682.00. The Council authorized payment of \$30,000 against this amount from the payoffs by users and the sewer construction fund account. To the remaining amount of \$61,682.00 he added interest for the next year to be pre-funded and some additional to allow for registration of the note, legal fees, etc.

Mr. Steineger distributed copies of the proposed Resolution No. 24 authorizing issuance of a Temporary Note in the amount of \$66,500.

Bob Van Cleave moved that Resolution No. 24 authorizing and directing the issuance of a renewal temporary note, Series 1983, in the amount of \$66,500 be adopted. The motion was seconded by Mark Grube. All aye. Motion carried.
