SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING HELD MARCH 8, 1980 AT CITY OFFICES

COUNCIL PRESENT: Anna Mary Landauer, Margaret Sterner, Milton Meyer, Jim Cook, Garry Eberth.

PRESIDING: Mayor Allen Goens

OTHERS PRESENT: Douglas Waters; city attorney, Sherrie Magaha, city clerk; citizens of the community.

The special meeting was called to order by Mayor Goens. He explained the purpose of the meeting which was to consider a public notice of the city's intent to issue revenue bonds. He asked Mr. Waters to explain to the citizens the difference between general obligation bonds and revenue bonds. Following this Mayor Goens told those in attendance the seriousness of the problem facing the city, mainly non-compliance of the city lagoons with federal laws. He read a summary of the proposed improvements and expansion plans. There was considerable discussion between the citizens and the council. The council and Mr. Waters answered any questions the citizens had concerning the wastewater facility plans or the funding. (A tape of the entire meeting is on file at city office).

VOTE ON PUBLIC NOTICE

Following the lengthy discussion, Mayor Goens called for a decision on the public notice. J. Cook moved to make application for revenue bonds in the amount of \$180,601.00 and that the authority continue for one year and publish the notice. Second by M. Sterner. 4 yes, 1 no, A. M. Landauer. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION FOR INDUSTRIAL COST RECOVERY

Mayor Goens told the council that he had a resolution which had to have council approval which had been overlooked at the regular meeting and was part of the grant application. J. Cook moved to approve the Industrial Cost Recovery Resolution. Second by M. Meyer. 5 yes. Motion carried. The resolution was assigned number 13.

HAVE PEOPLE WITH PROPERTY EASEMENTS ON SEWER PLAN AT NEXT MEETING

Mayor Goens told the city council that people who have property where easements for the sewer improvements are concerned should be contacted to attend the next council meeting. The council was asked to get with the city clerk to ascertain who they are and for the clerk to contact them.
