Regular Basehor City Council meeting, September 2, 1980

Basehor High School study hall

Council present: Garry Eberth, Anna Mary Landauer, Margaret Sterner, Jim Cook. Milton Meyer arrived at 8:15 p.m.

Presiding: Mayor Allen Goens

Minutes of the last meeting were presented. Anna Mary Landauer moved to accept regular minutes. Second by M. Sterner. 4 yes. Motion carried.

Public hearing on Revenue Sharing were presented. Mayor Goens stated the minutes stand approved as no one had any corrections or additions. No vote.

Budget hearing minutes were presented. Mayor Goens stated they stood approved as there were no additions or corrections. No vote.

Treasurer's Report

M. Sterner moved to reinvest C.D. #787. Second by G. Eberth. 4 yes. Motion carried.

A.M. Landauer moved to accept treasurer's report. Second by M. Sterner. 4 yes. Motion carried.

De-annexation of 142nd Street

M. Sterner moved to retain property on 142nd Street. Second by J. Cook. 3 yes; 1 no (A. M. Landauer) Motion carried.

Property trade

J. Cook moved that if the township would pay any excess surveying costs and share the cost of the title insurance that the city would execute the property trade. 4 yes. Motion carried.

Dahlin Sewer Hook-up

J. Cook moved to allow James M. Dahlin, 1713 155th Street, to hook-up to the city sewer system providing that he bear the cost of all easements, access lines, etc., under city restrictions. Second by M. Sterner. 5 yes. Motion carried.

Copy Machine Paper Contract

M. Sterner moved to accept a coupon contract with Modern Business Machines for copy paper and fluid mixture. Second by J. Cook. 5 yes. Motion carried.

Locks Changed At Office

M. Sterner moved to have the two locks changed at city office. Second by M. Meyer. 5 yes. Motion carried.

Sicle Purchased for mower

A. M. Landauer moved to purchase new sicle for the mower. J. Gatewood to purchase. Second by M. Sterner. 5 yes. Motion carried.

Sewer Grant Signed

J. Cook moved to allow Mayor Goens to sign the Sewer Grant. Second by M. Sterner. 4 yes. 1 abstained (A. M. Landauer). Motion carried.

ORDINANCES ACCEPTEDOrdinance #143--Loitering

A. M. Landauer moved to accept Ordinance #143 concerning loitering on the first reading. Second by M. Sterner. 5 yes. Motion carried.

J. Cook moved to declare an emergency and accept Ordinance #143 on the second reading. Second by M. Sterner. 5 yes. Motion carried.

Cereal Malt Ordinance

M. Sterner moved to accept the ordinance concerning the transportation of open containers of cereal malt beverages on the first reading. Second by A. M. Landauer. 5 yes. Motion carried.

ORDINANCES PRESENTED

Mr. Waters presented a proposed ordinance banning the use of bottle rockets with a fine of \$50.00 if a violation occurs.

J. Cook moved to accept the ordinance banning bottle rockets on the first reading. Second by M. Meyer. 5 yes. Motion carried.

SPECIAL MEETING CALLED

The council agreed to hold a special meeting on Sept. 11, 1980 at 7p.m. at city offices to discuss easements with the property owners in line with the sewer project. The city clerk was directed to notify them by phone and a letter to be sent certified-return receipt requested.

ENGINEER AUTHORIZED TO GO AHEAD WITH SEWER PROJECT

Carol Sindelar informed the council that E.P.A. letter stated that the engineer had to be authorized to go ahead with the sewer project. Mayor Goens authorized Mr. Martell to go ahead with the sewer project.
