DOWNES SPECIAL USE PERMIT APPROVED

The Mayor called the special meeting and public hearing to order for applications for day-care center. The first application for the Council to consider was for Donald and Mary Downes for a special use permit on property that is now the First Baptist Church between Hickory and Maple on 155th Terr. The Mayor asked if there were any property owners in that area present who had any objection to it or had any comments at all about it. Mr. Wilbur Grisham stated he would like to express objection to this as it was not constitutional. Mr. Grisham then raised some questions that pertained to church business and the Mayor explained to him that this should not be discussed at the meeting as far as the hearing was concerned. After much discussion between Mr. Grisham and the Council J. Cook moved, second by A. Goens to approve the special use permit for Mrs. Downes for the operation of a day-care center. Five yes-opposed none. Motion carried. The special meeting was recessed until 8 p.m. for the second public hearing.

MOODY APPROVED FOR SPECIAL USE PERMIT

The special meeting was called to order by the Mayor for the second public hearing. This hearing was on an application from Ross and Audrey Moody for a special use permit on a day-care center at their home, 15012 Parallel. The Mayor asked if there were any property owners in that area present that had any objections or comments. Mrs. Moody answered questions that the Council directed to her. A. Landauer moved, second by M. Meyer that the Council let Mr. and Mrs. Ross Moody have a day-care center in their home according to state specifications. Five yes-opposed none. Motion carried.

J. Cook moved to adjourn the special meeting and public hearing. The meeting adjourned at 8:04 p.m.
