## CONTINUED MEETING OF JULY 5, 1977

Mayor Worley called the meeting to order.

### STREETS

The first order of business was, Leo Martell presented contract for Harbour Bros. to repair and seal the following streets - 156th Terr. Poplar to Klamm Dr. including 1 block of Klamm Dr. - Leavenworth Rd. at 155th St. east to city limits - Olive St. - 154th Terr. Olive St. to Ripley - Ripley St. from 155th Terr. To 153rd Terr. - 153rd Terr. - Cedar St. - Elm St. or what part money will allow.

### MEETING PLACE

Anna Mary Landauer reported on using Middle School for meeting place of city. She reported this could be done, but school activities take priority over meetings. Motion to recend to August meeting - Jim Cook moved and John Ebert seconded. Four - yes, opposed none. John Novak asked Mayor Worley if he could contact Knights of Columbus Hall for lease of - Will tell us at August Meeting.

### DICTAPHONE

Council discussed to purchase dictaphone from office Catalogue - Olympic Sales Co. - Los Angeles California. Craig Dictation Equipment for office to be purchased in the amount of 189.75 plus mailing costs. Anna Mary Landauer moved Jim Cook seconded - four - yes, opposed none. Following this act the council recessed into executive session, to interview applicants for City Clerk.

### COUNCIL MEETING AGAIN OPEN TO PUBLIC

Council returned to the open meeting. Mayor opened, asking council to consider application of Wilma Kibler for City Clerk.- Two - yes, (Sterner, Cook) Two - No (Landauer, Ebert) Mayor voted yes breaking the tie. Wilma Kibler to take the position of City Clerk. Mayor mentioned that Mrs Thorne would be asked to fill in for three weeks while Mrs Kibler was out of office, with same salary pay of \$100 per week.

### POLICE OFFICIER

Police Chief Earl Heavis reported Jack Gatewood had completed training and asked for council's approval for police reserve. Four - yes, opposed none.

### BUDGET

Discussion on Budget opened, meeting date set for July 14, - 8:00P.M. at City Office, with Wayne Wolfe - A.M. Landauer. Motion moved and seconded. Four - yes, opposed none.

Mayor then moved that this meeting be adjourned, motion seconded. Four - yes opposed none. Motion Carried.
