Mayor Worley called the special meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

REVIEWING FINAL PLAT - RANKIN ESTATES PHASE I

The purpose of the meeting was to review the final plat of Rankin Estates Phase I. The Mayor brought to the Council's attention that there had been a change made on the plat. This was done after getting Mr. Waters opinion on the change. Mr. Waters stated that Coughlin Road could be changed on the plat to read Leavenworth Road as long as the change was made before the the Chairman of the Planning Commission had signed the plat. The Chairman of the Planning Commission was made aware of the change before he signed the plat.

After much discussion it was decided if all improvements were already completed that a performance bond was not necessary. After the improvements (sewer lines) had been installed and inspected by the City Engineer for his approval they would then bring it back to the Council for final approval on the subdivision. Upon the written recommendation from the Planning Commission J. Cook moved that the Council accept the final plat of Rankin Estates Phase I. M. Sterner gave a second to the motion. Four yes - opposed none. Motion carried.

Mayor Worley adjourned the meeting at 7:46 p.m.
