Special Council Meeting April 22, 1975

7:30 Fairmount Township Hall.

The purpose of this meeting was to consider solid waste exemptions and discuss animal control.

Council Members Present: Mayor Bernard Eberth, Council Members; David Cochran, John Ebert, John Novak. Clarence Worley and Anthony LoScalzo arrived late.


Others Present: many citizens of the community, Bert Barnes-Solid Waste Inc. rep,

Mayor Eberth allowed Mrs. Eileen Wilson to make a request to be on the May agenda to discuss a city wide ambulance for Basehor.

Mayor then made a recommendation to the council to allow exemption or reduction of the rate of \$1.00 per month from Solid Waste for all single member house holds plus a few hardship cases. His reason being was that he felt these people did not generate sufficient amount of refuse. Discussion followed with no motion given to this recommendation. Cochran moved second by Ebert that complete exemption be given to those filing for exemption that could show proof of; 1. No trash, 2. medical hardship or 3. undo financial hardship. Two yes-one no (Novak) and one abstention (Worley). Motion Carried. It was generally agreed by council, that any person that had not files an exemption may do so in the office of the city clerk, to be considered by council at a later date. Solid Waste service was then discussed. Mr. Bert Barnes stated that they pick-up some in Basehor then go to Linwood and back to Basehor to finish. According to Mr. Barnes this saves Solid Waste Inc. miles. LoScalzo stated he felt the medical exemption request should be supported by a physicians statement. Cochran suggested that all persons requesting exemption be made a part of the minutes by name and number assigned by council. The clerk was directed to write a letter to each person requesting exemption, informing them of council action. Cochran then made a motion second by LoScalzo that exemptions numbered 1 thru 54 be denied based on information given, that this list be made a part of the minutes as to name and number. The City Council was then polled on this motion: Cochran-yes, Ebert-yes, LoScalzo-yes, Worley-abstained and Novak-yes. Motion Carried. There were nine exemptions selected by council that needed additional information. Council directed that a letter requesting additional information be sent to these nine people.

Cochran informed council that 13 attempts have been made to contact Animal Control to ask them to attend this meeting and no one answered the phone. He said he will keep trying and will invite them to attend the May meeting.

This meeting was adjourned.
