Council Meeting May 7, 1974

Council Members Present: Mayor Eberth, Councilmen-Clarence Worley, David Cochran, Tony LoScalzo, John Ebert, John Novak.

Others Present: John Murray, City Attorney; Richard Warden, City Treasurer; Harry Zacharias, Animal Control Office; Earl Reavis, Chief of Police; Leslie Shaughnessy, acting city clerk; citizens of the community

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Eberth. Minutes of the regular meeting April 2, 1974 were approved as printed.

Treasurers report was presented. Discussion followed. Motion by Cochran second by LoScalzo to invest \$4,000.00 in Treasury Bills from Special Fuel Fund, \$7,000.00 from Bond and Interest, \$3,500.00 from the Sewer Department, \$1,000.00 Revenue Sharing and enough out of the General Fund to make up the difference on two Treasury Bills to come due in 90 days for a total amount of \$20,000.00. 5-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried. Appropriation Ordinance #84 was approved.

Neu Plumbing and Heating request for payment was approved in accordance with ordinance #84 less tax.

Frank Strick and Norman Hlomes appeared concerning an 80 acre tract in north Basehor, Councilman Novak stated this land must first be annexed into Basehor before a plat could be considered. Mr. Strick was told these forms are in the office of the city clerk.

Reavis stated dogs are still creating problems.

Zacharias stated Ormy Kemler wants to start a Kennel. Much discussion followed. No Action.

Jim McKenzie appeared to request the use of City equipment at the high school for two new ball diamonds. Council agreed to this-Worley will do the blade work.

Warden gave the Municipal Judge report.

Cochran stated City Police car does not seem to be partolling the residential area. Discussion followed. Reavis was directed to inform Reserves Officers of this and see to it that more residential partolling is done.

Sewer stoppage in north part of town in Klamm addition was discussed. Worley stated the stoppage was caused by 2X4's that had been put in the manhole. Discussion followed on putting bars across the manhole to lock them up.

Mayor was authorized to pay Sam Kemler \$25.00 for rock storage rental.

Discussion followed concerning the charge to the city by the Fairmount Township Board for use of the Hall for meetings. Worley stated they will charge \$2.00 per meeting. Council discussed how many meetings they are responsible for-Planning Commission, Council and Police Court. Clerk was directed to write to the Township and ask for a lease stating rent procedures.

Clerk was directed to invite a representative from the school board to the city budget meeting to discuss crossing guards. Clerk to get information from Councilman Ebert on this letter.

Bids for solid waste were discussed. Only one bid has been turned in--Saladin. Much discussion followed. Clerk was directed to send a copy of the ordinance to Dave Folsom.

Mr. Folsom appeared at the meeting to discuss with council Ordinance #94.

Mayor stated Ace Pipe Cleaning Inc. has a sewer maintenance program. Clerk was instructed to write to them and request a proposal.

Worley requested that the Revenue Sharing report be filled out and published.

Murray then gave the second and final reading for Ordinance #93, an ordinance for signs and billboards, adoption by reference. Cochran moved second by LoSclazo this ordinance be adopted on the second reading. 5-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Murray then gave the first reading for Ordinance #94, an ordinance contracting with private refuse contractors. Novak moved second by Cochran this ordinance be adopted. 5-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

New sewer billing clerk was then discussed. There were 22 people applying. Virginia Williams was present to apply. Cochran stated she is a trained accountant. Clerk was directed to contact all persons interested and get information; bid-qualification-experience. Then call Mayor who will poll the council.

Murray will not be available from June 5th through 15th.

Novak moves second by Cochran this meeting be adjourned.
