Council Meeting December 2, 1974

Council Members Present: Mayor Eberth, Councilmen-Clarence Worley, David Cochran, Anthony LoScalzo, John Ebert, John Novak.

Others Present: John Murray, City Attorney; Richard Warden, City Treasurer; Sylvia Lovvorn, City Clerk; Leo Martell, City Engineer; citizens of the community.

Minutes of the November 12, 1974, meeting were corrected and approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer's report was then considered. Council agreed to an increase of Bond for the city treasurer to \$50,000.00 which will carry a premium of \$293.00 per year. Warden stated the bond for the City Inspector-Novo-Gradac will be canceled since he does not handle any money. Warden was directed to continue billing Robert Eberth for sewer service on his unoccupied rental property since this has been the procedure in the past. Warden was directed to check with Wayne Wolf on a reimbursement of special highway not to exceed \$4,000.00. Cochran moved second by Worley to reinvest \$10,000.00 from Treasury Bill dated 12/12/74 for 90 days. Five yes-opposed none. Motion Carried. Motion by LoScalzo second by Cochran to accept this report and that appropriation Ordinance #91 be adopted as printed. Motion Carried with 5-yes-no opposed.

ENVIRONMENTAL LAB--discussion

Mr. Leon Edwards made a presentation for the Environmental Laboratories, Inc. concerning testing of lagoons required by the state. The quote included sampling of influent and effluent, submission of quarterly reports, retention of all data and reports for (3) years, immediate notification to the proper city personnel if its test results indicate the city is in violation of limitations. The amount of this quarterly testing was \$100.00 per quarter. Much discussion followed with no action by council.

CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE LICENSE

Joe Daniels appeared to ask council direction on a cereal malt beverage license for J. R. Waymire who has purchased the Daniel's Market. Following much discussion the clerk was directed to accept a check for \$100.00 and the application from Mr. Waymire, to receipt Mr. Waymire pending the January council action.

NEW RESERVES

Cheif Reavis asked council for time and date to interview new reserves applications. This date was set for 12/10/74 at 7:30.

Sandy Lacy offered to do volunteer crossing guards. This matter will be considered.

OFFICE EQUIPMENT FOR POLICE

Cochran donated a desk to the police department.

CLERK'S OFFICE DESIGNATED CITY OFFICES

Discussion followed concerning the move of the city clerk's office to the front of the Basehor Sentinel building. It was decided that the Basehor Police Department will also have an office with desk and filing cabinet in the city office. Clerk was directed to have a sign made that says CITY OFFICES, cost not to exceed \$15.00.

LEONARD LACY-DAMAGE TO CAR

Following much discussion a motion was made by Novak and second by Ebert to pay the \$200.00 repair bill for Lacy's personal car which occurred during a high speed chase which the Daniel's Market robbery took place. This to be paid from city funds. Five yes-no opposed. Motion Carried.

MARTELL-CITY ENGINEER

Martell reported on feasibility study involving a Federal Grant. He stated that should a grant be acquired the government would pay 75% of the total project, but would not pay for filling out grant application. He further stated that the Mayor must sign as official on grant and a resolution must be passed to get the application on file. Martell felt that it would take at least two meetings to fill out the application before he could give a cost figure. Novak moved second by Ebert to direct Martell to prepare the application for the sewer treatment. 5-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

SIDEWALK DISCUSSION

After much discussion Ebert moved second by Worley that Martell be directed to measure and shoot grade for a sidewalk between Maple and Hickory on the west side of 155th Street. Five yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

CITY ENGINEER-STATEMENT

Martell presented his bill to date in the amount of \$345.00. LoScalzo moved second by Cochran that this bill be paid. Five yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

SIGN PERMIT FORMS

Attorney Murray presented the sign permit forms for council approval. Following examination and discussion this form was approved.

EBERT--CITY ENGINEER OF LEAVENWORTH

Councilman Ebert present his report on the possibility of the City of Leavenworth doing the lagoon sampling for Basehor. Following much discussion Ebert recommended the letter of authorization be sent. Cochran moved second by Novak this recommendation be accepted and that the letter be sent to Don Seba,

engineer for the City of Leavenworth. Five yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

OCCUPATION PERMIT

Council discussed a occupation permit for Basehor. It was the feeling of the council that a sample ordinance should be studied. This matter was tabled pending further study.

PLANNING COMMISSION LETTER-dated November 7, 1974

Council discussed recommended amendment-for trailor permit. Clerk was directed to return this matter to the planning commission for further reconsideration as the council felt the amendment at this time is not warranted. Subject of waiving water requirments was then discussed. Council directed the clerk to write a letter to the Planning Commission directing them to consider any plat presented to them and then inform council of their findings.

RICKEL STREETS

Martell reported ^{on} a letter from Bacon concerning Rickel streets. Mayor Eberth reported the ~~grading has been done~~, on the Rickel streets.

SOLID WASTE CONTRACT

Mayor stated Virginia Williams quoted a price of 30¢ per unit to do the trash billing. No action. LoScalzo moved second by Ebert that a contract be adwarded for solid waste at this meeting. Much discussion followed with LoScalzo retracting his motion. All bids were then reviewed again. Following much discussion Cochran moved second by LoScalzo that the contract be adwarded to Solid Waste from Leavenworth subject to the working out of an acceptable contract, with service to begin February 1, 1975. Five-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried. Meeting with contractor was set for 12/18/74 at 8:00 Murray will be present.

This meeting was adjourned.
