Recessed meeting of the Basehor City Council August 10, 1973

Council Present: Mayor Eberth; Councilmen-Clarence Worley, David Cochran, John Ebert, Anthony LoScalzo, John Novak.

Others Present: John Murray, City Attorney; Sylvia Lovvorn, City Clerk; K.C. Viets, City Engineer; David Norris, Principal of Junior High, Marvin Kemler, Kenneth Novo-Gradac, Ray Goddard, Citizens of the community.

David Norris appeared to explain the Bus situation at the Junior High. Discussion followed. Mr. Norris stated he would present to the school board the possibility of a circular drive on the East side of the Junior High so the buses can load and unload off the street.

Building Inspector interviews then took place. Those interviewed by Council were: Marvin Kemler, Ken Novo-Gradac and Ray Goddard. Following much discussion Worley nominated Ken Novo-Gradac second by LoScalzo. John Ebert nominated Marvin Kemler. On a ballot vote Novo-Gradac received three votes and Kemler received two. It was then agreed by Council that Novo-Gradac would not take office until his duties were clearly spelled out. This will be done at a meeting of full council, special committee and K.C. Viets. Meeting to be held at 7:30 Fairmount Township Hall August 17th, 1973.


The Mayor appointment to the Planning Commission then took place. This appointment was to fill the position held by Robert Raines. Mayor appointed Wayne Trail. Vote of Council was none. Mayor then appointed, by request of Ebert, Mrs. Dale Breuer. Vote of council was two for. Mayor then appointed, by request of Cochran, Dwight Wheelan. Vote of Council was two for.

Second round of voting went as follows: Mrs. Dale Breuer 2 yes-3 no, Leonard Lacy 2 yes-3 no, Dwight Wheelan 4 yes-1 no. Wheelan was appointed to the Planning Commission subject to his acceptance of the position.

Ebert then brought up the need of a 400 watt street light instead of a 250 W on 150th and Parallel. Council agreed to a 400 being on 150th and Parallel.

Council then voted 5-yes-opposed none to replace Charles Hobbs with Dwight Wheelan on the traffic study committee.

There being no further business this meeting was adjourned.
