City Council Meeting December 4th, 1973
Council Members Present; Mayor Eberth, Councilman Clarence Worley, John Ebert, ~~John~~
S.L. Ebert, John Novak, Anthony LoSaclzo.

Others Present; Richard Warden, City Treasurer; John Murray, City Attorney; Sylvia Lovvorn, City Clerk; Ken Novo-Gradac, City Inspector.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Eberth. Minutes of the regular meeting November 6th, 1973 were corrected and approved as printed. Novak moved second by Worley the corrected minutes be approved. 4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Treasurers report was considered. Murray recommended council reconsider transfer of \$423.52 motion in the November minutes to read from Revenue Sharing to pay directly to street lights. LoScalzo moved second by Worley-council reconsider the motion to transfer the \$423.52 from Revenue Sharing to General Fund. 4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

LoScalzo then moved second by Ebert the City pay the past three months (Oct, Nov & Dec), street light bill of \$420.03 from Revenue Sharing. 4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

LoScalzo moved second by Novak the Treasurers report be approved as corrected and appropriation Ordinance #79 be adopted. 4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Warden stated that sewer bills have been sent to the K of C Hall for the past three months and are not being paid. Discussion followed. The statement was made that the Hall was hooked on to the pastor's house and this is not permitted. LoScalzo stated Warden should present the sewer bills to Joe Nick for payment. Warden also stated that Wilbur Peterson has not paid his sewer bill. Sewer billing clerk will be directed to write Mr. Peterson informing him this unpaid amount will be added to his taxes.

LoScalzo questioned--if there was a hook-up fee due from the Catholic Church? It was stated that there should have been a \$200.00 charge for the hook-up. Novo-Gradac was instructed to inquire as to how the hook-up was made and inform them of the monthly charge, also of the \$200.00 cost for the hook-up due the City, plus a \$3.00 tapping permit is required. Novo-Gradac will check with other churches as to how they handled hook-up.

Novak stated that some citizens in the Rickel addition have been calling him about the weeds on the Rickel property on Circle Drive. Discussion followed. No action.

Revais reported that the bids for the radio grants are out.

The January meeting was set to be held January 8th due to the holiday.

Novo-Gradac stated that Elevier is still holding about 10" of water and has been notified by him. Also that Smith-Lovelace has repaired the left pump.

Novak moved second by LoScalzo that the balance due Bruce Browne of \$2,915.93 be paid from the Basehor Sewer fund. 4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Letter from Rabuse, general maintenance contractor, was read by the Mayor and put on file in the office of the clerk.

Mayor then read a letter from the Environmental Protection Agency. Murray recommended the council request Bruce Browne fill out information needed and return for Mayor signature.

Clerk was directed to mail this request to Mr. Browne.

Ordinance #91, was given the second reading. Novak moved second by Ebert Ordinance #91 be adopted on the second and final reading. 4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Ordinance #92, concerning parking on one side of the street, was tabled for further study.

The matter of further annexation was discussed. Murray gave his opinion on the matter in writing. A copy of this is on file in the office of the clerk. Murray was asked to investigate the property belonging to Staat~~s~~ for annexation at the January meeting.

Letter to the county engineer concerning road and street work to be done for the city by the county was discussed. Mayor Eberth and Clarence Worley will prepare information needed for this letter.

Council approved a request from Jim Novo-Gradac for a plumbing license. Novak moved second by Ebert this request be allowed. 4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Road equipment for Basehor was then discussed. Clerk was then directed to write a letter to the County Commissioners and the County Engineer informing them of our need to be considered for any equipment going up for sale. Novak moved second by Ebert this letter be approved. 4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

There being no further business this meeting was adjourned.
