Special Meeting
Feb 18, 1972

Councilmen Present: Bernard Eberth, Mayor; Farris Roberts, John Ebert, Clarence Worley, Anthony LoScalzo, David Cochran.
Others Present; John Murray, City Attorney; Clinton Warden, City Treasurer; Kelly Viets, City Engineer. Citizens of the community.

Councilman Ebert presented the proposed work order form. Discussion followed. Ebert was asked to draft this form and present to Council.

Mayor Eberth read a letter from the City Planning Commission. Attorney Murray was asked to draft a letter form to property owners notifying them of their annexation to the City of Basehor. Planning Commission recommends Mr. Neuman be denied his request to move a house trailer into Basehor. This would be in violation of Ordinance #13-Sec13 Sub Sec 9. Cochran moves seconded by Roberts this recommendation be accepted. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Mussett rezoning was then discussed. No action was taken.

It was then decided that the Council would discuss Mobil Homes at the next meeting. Kelly Viets was asked to bring an example of a Mobile Home Ordinance. Murray will bring one from Leavenworth.

The Clerk was directed to write a letter to the Rural Water Board informing them of the City Council desire to attend their March 10th meeting.

LoScalzo moved seconded by Worley the City of Basehor send a check for \$2,000.00 to Ed Powers for the purpose of installing a warning siren, this amount to be returned to the City with in one year. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Ordinance #55-a redraft of and replacement for Ordinance #45 was given the second reading. Cochran moved seconded by Ebert Ordinance #55 be adopted on the second and final reading. 5 yes-opposed none. motion carried.

It was then decided by Council that in the event the regular meeting can not be concluded in the regular monthly meeting of the first Tues a meeting will be called and the date set at the regular meeting. This would allow the continued meeting time and date to be announced in the Basehor Sentinel.

Attorney Murray then gave the first reading for annexation Ordinances #60-61-62-63-64. Ebert moved seconded by Roberts these Ordinances be approved on the first reading. 5 yes-opposed none. motion carried.

The Clerk was directed to have Mr. Zacharias to move the City Limits sign to the highway 24-40 south of Basehor.

Council discussed rental space for the City. It was decided that a lease would be prepared between the City of Basehor and Mr. and Mrs. Cleveland Lovvorn. Murray was asked to draw up this lease. *Retrospective Jan 1, 1972*
A motion was made by Cochran seconded by LoScalzo this lease be drafted. 5 yes-opposed none. motion carried.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
