City Council Meeting

March 7, 1972

Council Members Present: Bernard Eberth, Mayor; Councilmen; Farris Roberts, David Cochran, John Ebert, Clarence Worley, Anthony LoScalzo.

Other Present: John Murray, City Attorney; Richard Warden, City Treasurer; Sylvia Lovvorn, City Clerk; Citizens of the Community.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Eberth. Minutes of the previous meeting of Feb1, 1972 were read and approved.

Treasurers report was read by Warden. Cochran moved seconded by Ebert that the report be accepted and approation Ordinance #58 be approved. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Murray presented proposed form letter that will be sent to property owners newly annexed to the City of Basehor. Council then discussed the letter and directed the Clerk to send one to each property owner newly annexed.

Murray then read the lease for the rental of City Clerks Office between Cleve and Sylvia Lovvorn and the City of Basehor. Discussion followed and it was agreed when Libility insurance had been supplied this lease would be accepted. LoScalzo moved seconded by Roberts this lease be approved. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

During the petition and request much discussion ensued concerning the property of Mr. Allison as to zoning Lot1 B11 & Lot 1 B12 Rickels Sudbivision #2. The Council heard from many citizens, Frank Rahija, & Mr. Allison. The Mayor then instructed all present that the Council would take all statements under advisment when studing the Master Plan.

Murray presented the Mobil Home Ordinance from Leavenworth for the Council to study.

It was stated by Council that the City should consider an occupation permit. NO Action was taken.

Councilman Ebert presented the form for work orders. Worley moved second by Cochran this form be adopted. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Ordinance #65, an Ordinance repealing Ordinance #56 and providing for the annexation of property belonging to Joe Landauer Jr. was given the second reading. Ebert moved second by Roberts Ordinance #65 be adopted on the second and final reading. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Ordinance #66, an Ordinance repealing Ordinance #58 and providing for the annexation of property belonging to Louie Banzhaf & Orme Kemler was given the second reading. LoScalzo moved second by Ebert Ordinance #66 be adopted on the second and final reading. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Ordinance #60, an Ordinance providing for the annexation of property belonging to Gene Owen was given the second reading. Cochran moved second by Ebert Ordinance #60 be adopted on the second and final reading. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Ordinance ⁶³ #, an Ordinance providing for the annexation of property belonging to William Lewis was given the second reading. Ebert moved second by Roberts Ordinance #63 be adopted on the second and final reading. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Ordinance #64, an ordinance providing for the annexation of property belonging to William Gardner was given the second reading. Ebert moved second by LoScalzo ordinance #64 be adopted on the second and final reading. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.
