

Recessed Meeting April 18th of the City Council

Meeting called to order by Mayor Eberth,

Cochran ask Planning Commission if they made any changes in their recommendation concern-
ing the Master Plan. Raines replied no changes had been made.

Murray was directed to redraft annexation Ordinance #71 concerning Meyer Diary for the
next regular meeting.

Raines ask for clarifiacion of Ordinance #35 concerning the moving of houses into Basehor.
Much discussion followed. He was told that the \$50.00 inspection fee was to be turned
over to the City Treasurer, however if there were expenses to the Two City Planners sent
to inspect the house these would be paid by the City.

The City Clerk was ask to make an appointment with Mrs. Botkin for inspection of house to
be moved into Basehor. City Planners ask to inspect were: Mr. George Klinkenburg and Mr.
Gleen Hubbel.

Carl Banzhaf appeared asking if he could sell his 4 ac~~res~~ for building 4 houses. Murray
read from the proposed zoning ordinance. Sec 2.3. Murray stated since he was in the City
he could sell his property in one ac~~res~~ lots.

There being no further business Roberts moved second by Cochran the meeting was adjourned.
