City Council Members Present: Bernard Eberth, Mayor; Councilmen; Farris Roberts,

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Eberth. Minutes of the previous meeting March 7th, 1972 were read and approved.

Treasurers report was read by Warden, Council requested Kelly Viets, City Engineer present a statement for work done in 1971. Ebert moved second by Cochran the report be accepted and approation Ordinance #59 be approved. 4 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Council then discussed the letter from the City Planning Commission dated March 22, 1972 concerning; Commercial building permits & A.K. Mussett petition for rezoning. It was the feeling of the Council that since there had been no commerical permits applied for in some time such permits would not be withheld but the Clerk was directed to notify Council of such a request for Mayor and Council approval at a special meeting. Mr. Raines & Mr. Karl Banzhaf ask to be present when and if such a meeting is called. Council agreed that any action on the Mussett request be postponed until the next regular meeting in May.

Vincent Wynne, builder for William G. Paul appeared before the council to request a building permit on Tract 10 of the Gene Owen property. Mr. Wynne presented the Council with a recorded abstract dated 3 days prior to annexation. In view of this Councilman Roberts moved second by Cochran that Mr. Wynne's request to build be granted. 3 yes-1 opposed (Worley). Motion Carried.

Cochran moved second by worley Dr. Wasson, Veterarian, be authorized to vaccinate dogs for the City of Basehor. 4 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Warden reported for the sewer billing Clerk Judy Paski. It was stated that there were several property owners that are deliquent by several months in paying the sewer service charges. Following discussion Attorney Murray was authorized by Council to send a letter to these people at the end of 3 months informing them that a Mechaines Lien will be attached to their property.

Cochran moved second by Ebert a check for \$3.75 be given to Mr. Miller & Mr. Fincher for attending the First Aid course in Tonganoxie. 4 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

A letter from Bruce Browne to B.E. Hunt, dated March 17, 1972 and concerning re-seeding all graded areas at the two lagoon sites, was read. Following much discussion Attorney Murray was directed to write a letter to Bruce Browne informing him if seeding has not been done by April 20th the City will go ahead and have seeding done and charge B.E. Hunt against the funds that are being held for him.

A letter dated March 7, 1972 from Mr. E. Morgan Williams-State Director FHA concerning possible takeover of the rural water district by the city of Basehor, was read. Discussion followed. No action taken.

W.C. Rickel appeared before council to present completed sewer system Lateral's G5-1 & G5-2 also requested acceptance for sewer Lateral G-8. At this time the letter of recommendation from the City Engineer, Kelly Viets was read. Cochran moved second by Ebert these sewer laterals be accepted when work on manholes mentioned in engineers letter has been complete and has been inspected by City Inspector, Connie Crocker.
4-yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Council requested a written report by City Engineer on tube to be installed at 155th & Poplar.

Ebert moved second by Cochran that a petty cash fund be set up for use by the City Clerk in the amount \$15.00. A monthly report will be submitted to Council. Tickets will be presented to the City Treasurer. 4 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

The Clerk was directed by Council to have a sign put up on the Basehor Sentinel building to say "Basehor City Clerk". Cost not to exceed \$15.00.
