Special Council Meeting
Jan. 19, 1971

Council Members present: Acting Mayor Bernard Eberth, Councilmen Robert Raines, Lester Worley, Farris Roberts and Robert Van Tuyl.

Others present: Charles Newman, City Clerk, Bruce Browne, Engineer, Allen Goens, Dale Allison, Charles Hobbs, William Rickel and John Novak.

The meeting was called to order by Acting Mayor Eberth. This being a special meeting no minutes of previous meetings were read or treasurers report given.

Bruce Browne presented and discussed the problem of sewer lines serving the Hobbs, Allison and Goens properties in the Rickel Addition. After lengthy discussion it was generally agreed that Allison and Hobbs would connect their properties to the existing 4" sewer line that was installed under the city contract. The Goens property will connect to an 8" sewer line that is to be installed by Wm. Rickel.

The marking of the word POLICE on the car used by Chief of Police Swope was discussed however because of the lack of information governing such markings no action was taken. Regulations on such cars will be investigated.

The question of receiving an 80% grant from the Federal Government toward the purchase of law enforcement equipment was presented to the Council. Discussion was limited because of insufficient information about such a program. The Council will investigate and seek information about such federal grants.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
