Special Meeting at Basehor High School to hear complaints of Sewer Appraisement.

Council Members Present: Acting Mayor Bernard Eberth, Councilmen Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl and Farris Roberts.

Others Present: John Murray, City Attorney; Bruce Browne, Engineer; Bob Thompson, Bonding Company representative; Charles Newman, City Clerk; and approximately 150 citizens of the community.

John Murray opened the meeting by explaining the purpose of the meeting was to hear complaints of the sewer appraisements. He further stated that the total appraised value of Lateral Districts #1 and #2 was \$699,280.00. Total cost of the sewer project collection system was \$190,900.00.

Based on a bond issue of \$190,900.00 for a period of 20 years, the average principle and interest per year would be \$16,430.00. Broken down on a \$1,000.00 valuation, the principle and interest per year would be \$23.50 per year or \$470.00 over the 20 year period. A \$1,000.00 valuation paid off in cash would be \$275.00. Such cash transaction must be finalized within 30 days after the appraisements have been confirmed by the Council.

Following a question and answer period regarding bond issue and the methods of payment by individual property owners, Murray directed the property owners present who had complaints against the appraisements to file their complaints.

Due to the large number of complaints and the late hour, the Council members postponed hearing the complaints. A special meeting for the hearing was set for March 30, 1971, at 8:00 p.m. at the Township Hall.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
