City Council Meeting
December 7, 1971

Council members Present: Bernard Eberth, Mayor; Councilman Farris Roberts
David Cochran, John Ebert, Clarence Wroley, Anthony
LoScalzo.

Others Present: John Murray, City Attorney; Sylvia Lovvorn, City Clerk; Richard
Warden, City Treasurer; Citizens of the Community.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Eberth. Minutes of the previous meeting
of November 2, 1971 were read and approved.

The Treasurers report was read by Warden. Ebert moved seconded by Cochran that
the report be accepted and appropriation Ordinance #55 be approved with the
following correction, concerning the bill presented by Harbour Brothers for re-
surfacing of streets, since there were some roads incorrectly oiled payment
should be with held until corrected. 4 yes opposed none. Motion Carried.

Further discussion followed; It was noted that the agreement with Harbour was
that the resurfacing of Basehor streets would not exceed \$5,000.00. The Bill
was for \$5,112.00. Roberts moved seconded by Worley that partial payment of
\$4,000.00 be made due to incorrect oiling and amount of bill. 4 yes opposed
none Motion Carried.

Municipal Judge Franklin reported one hearing in November dismissed due to lack
of evidence.

Street maintenance report read and approved for Mr. Zacharias.

City Inspector reported on bill submitted by Carl Rickel of \$305.67 for in-
stalling 8" pipe to Allen Goens property. Recommending that the bill be ad-
justed from \$305.67 to \$291.87. This was agreeable with Mr. Rickel. Roberts
moved seconded by Worley adjusted bill be allowed. 4 yes-opposed none Motion
Carried.

Mayor Eberth spoke to Council concerning Mr. Swope. Mr. Swope has taken a job
for the next 60 days in Kansas City therefor will not be on duty in Basehor
during the day. Mayor Eberth continued with statements from Swope--he would
resign or take a tempary leave of absents according to the wish of the Council.
He will be on duty nights in Basehor. The Clerk was directed to notify Mr.
Kiester Super of Schools and Officer Earl Reavis of this change. No action
taken.

Cochran moved seconded by Ebert that the Basehor Sentinel become the legal
publication for the City of Basehor. Effective Jan 1, 1972. 4 yes-opposed
none Motion Carried.

Council then ask that the Sentinel submitt a publication rate and written

Mayor Eberth informed the council that Mr. Grube is requesting that the City put a street in to serve his property. Attorney Murray stated that the City is obligated to open a street but that surfacing and improving would be at the expense of Mr. Grube. Council then requested that Mr. Grube be present at the next regular Council meeting with a drawing of his plans. No action was taken.

The letter from Bruce Browne, concerning the seeding on lagoons, was then read. Council then agreed that the interest money due Mr. Bryce Hunt will be withheld until there is a seed stand as the contract states. Mayor stated that Council will look at lagoons again. Mayor will talk to Eyerly about work needing to be done on lagoons.

Worley moved seconded by Cochran that Ordinance #45 be redrafted by Murray and re-assigned #55. 4 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Worley moved seconded by Ebert that Mrs. Bill Klamm be reimbursed for cost of laying sewer line under high way. Amount \$235.00 for rental property south of fire station on 155th Street now in Lateral #2. 4 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

Mr. O.D. Allison--603 South Main--Clinton, Mo. appeared before Council to state he had not received any notice of the special assessment on his property, now he is being charged the full amount plus interest for 20 annual instalments. Lots in question were Lot 1 Bl1 and Lot 1 Bl 2 Rickel Sub-division #2.

Correction to be made on Grube BCF-610 Lot 7 Bl 9. Clerk was ask to get the correct lot number that the house is on.

Councilman LoScalzo arrived at meeting.

Ebert submitted two names to Police Auxillary for Council consideration. They were: Bob Miller and John Fincher. Council ask for recommendation from Chief of Police Swope and that these men appear before the Council.

Cochran moved seconded by Roberts that the bill received from the Kansas League of Muninipalities be paid. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

This bill includes Membership and Subscriptions for Kansas Journal.

LoScalzo moved seconded by Ebert that renewal of the Daniels Malt and Beverage liscense be approved following complication of application. 5 yes-opposed none. Motion Carried.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
