

CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS
Special Council Meeting
Jan. 10, 1970

Present: Acting Mayor Bernard Eberth, Councilmen Farris Roberts,
Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl, and Lester Worley.

Others present: Charles Newman, City Clerk.

Acting Mayor Eberth called the meeting to order by stating that the purpose of such meeting was to authorize additional temporary notes for the sewer project.

Ordinance #29 authorizing the construction of a sewage disposal facility and all necessary and incidental appurtenances thereto, for the City of Basehor was introduced. Van Tuyl moved, seconded by Roberts, that Ordinance #29 be passed. Four votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.

Resolution for issuance of temporary notes #1, #2, #3, and #4 (Sewage Disposal) in the denomination of \$25,000.00 each to pay the cost of constructing a sewage disposal facility, and all the necessary appurtenances thereto, for the City of Basehor was introduced. Roberts moved, seconded by Van Tuyl, that the resolution be passed and that the Acting Mayor and City Clerk be directed to execute the temporary notes #1, #2, #3, and #4. Four votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.

Ordinance #30 authorizing and providing for the issuance of temporary notes of the City of Basehor to provide funds to pay the cost of constructing a sewage disposal facility, and all necessary and incidental appurtenances thereto, for the City of Basehor was introduced. Raines moved, seconded by Worley, that Ordinance #30 be passed. Four votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.

Resolution for issuance of temporary note #3 in the denomination of \$40,000.00 to pay for the costs of construction of sewer system of Lateral Sewer District #1 was introduced. Raines moved, seconded by Worley, that the resolution be passed and that the Acting Mayor and City Clerk be directed to execute temporary note #3 of Lateral Sewer District #1. Four votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
