Special Council Meeting  
May 20, 1970

Council Members Present: Mayor Alfred Meyer, Councilmen Robert Raines, Lester Worley, Robert Van Tuyl, and Farris Roberts.

Others Present: Charles Newman, City Clerk, and Richard Warden, City Treasurer.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Meyer. Since this was a special meeting, no minutes were read and treasurer's report given.

Mayor Meyer opened for discussion the question of the amount the City of Basehor will pay a contractor for bringing a sewer line across a street. The city will furnish sewer pipe and pay a contractor for excavating and laying 30 feet of sewer pipe. The following amounts were presented by Mayor Meyer as suggested by one of the local contractors for the work of excavating trench and laying pipe:

\$75.00 up to and including 8 feet deep.  
\$85.00 up to and including 12 feet deep.  
\$100.00 over 12 feet deep.

There was a general discussion of the question; however, no action was taken.

The type of bill to be sent out for sewer service charge was discussed. The sewer account will be titled, "Basehor Sewer Department."

Mayor Meyer appointed Raines and Warden, along with the person hired to handle the service charge billing, to serve as a committee to review and recommend the type of bill and procedures for billing the sewer service charge.

Persons hooking on to the sewer will be billed as of the first of the month following the month during which the hookup was made.

Mayor Meyer presented the following three applicants for the position of billing clerk for the sewer department:

Mrs. Nancy Hansen - bid 25¢ per unit for billing  
Mrs. Sylvia Lovvorn - bid 25¢ per unit for billing  
Mrs. Judy Piasecky - bid 20¢ per unit for billing

Following a discussion of the qualifications and the bids made by each applicant, Mayor Meyer appointed Mrs. Judy Piasecky as billing clerk for the sewer department.

Raines moved, seconded by Roberts, that the appointment be approved. Three votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.
