Special Council Meeting  
Sept. 8, 1970

Council Members Present: Mayor Alfred Meyer, Councilmen Robert Raines,  
Farris Roberts, Lester Worley.

Treasurer.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Meyer. This being a special meeting, no minutes were read and no treasurer's report given.

Following a discussion of the curfew ordinance as drafted by City Attorney Murray, Raines moved, seconded by Roberts, that the reading of the curfew ordinance be tabled because of a need for the clarification of certain points contained in the ordinance.

Raines moved, seconded by Worley, that the resolution confirming the appointment of Gene Drake, Leavenworth Mutual, Lambert Mills, Citizens Mutual, and George Hobbs, Realtor, as appraisers for Lateral Sewer District #1 be approved. Three votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.

Raines moved, seconded by Roberts, that the resolution confirming the appointments of Gene Drake, Lambert Mills, and George Hobbs as appraisers for Lateral Sewer District #2 be approved. Three votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.

Mayor Meyer reported that as yet there had been no response to the notice advertising for bids for cutting weeds at the sewer lagoons. Meyer further stated that he had contacted local plumbers about maintenance of the lift station and checking the water level at the lagoons. Frank Eyerly indicated an interest in the job at \$10.00 per week; however if additional work is required beyond the inspecting, this would be an additional \$5.00 per hour if a plumber is needed plus additional expense for use of equipment. No action was taken on the question.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
