

CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS
COUNCIL MEETING OF JANUARY 7, 1969

Acting Mayor Eberth called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Robert Raines, Charles Kemler and Robert Van Tuyl.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney, Bruce Browne, Engineer, Eugene Poggemeyer from Planning Commission, Jim McClurg, George Klinkenberg and Alfred Mussett representing committee to look into fire insurance rating.

Minutes of December 3 and December 19, 1968 meetings were read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Raines moved and seconded by Kemler to accept trasurers report as read. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Bruce Browne presented sewer progress report. State Board of Health letter to Engineer stated they found no objections. Metro plan review tentatively set for 3:30 January 15, 1969. Aerial photo finished. Field work about finished. Approximate bid date now April, depending on when approval received from all agencies involved.

Mussett presented Fire rating problem. Requested council backing for pursuing the problem with Inspection Bureau. Council agreed it was a good idea to follow up by the Grange Committee. Basehor presently rated as without fire protection. Problem may be brought on the City because of some correspondence from Inspection Bureau to former Mayor and township officials which Inspection Bureau claims no answer received by them. Subject correspondence requested ordinance be passed creating Fire Department and that equipment be brought up to their standards, with reply to be made within 30 days of their letters.

There being no furthur business the meeting adjourned.
