

CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS
COUNCIL MEETING OF FEBRUARY 4, 1969

Acting Mayor Eberth called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Robert Raines, Charles Kemler, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney, Ward Kiester, Kent Wheeler, Wes Kenton, Fred Sterner and Paul Jones.

Minutes of January 7, 1969 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Raines moved and seconded by ~~W~~ Worley to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mr. Kiester presented for discussion the problem of the State having cut off Highway 72 at the south City limits. Murray to contact Dempsey and Reilly for their help. Delegation from the City to talk with highway commissioner also.

Acting Mayor Eberth presented request from John Landauer that city rock street to Burn's place. Request denied inasmuch as City has not accepted street, therefore is private drive.

Engineers report read by Councilman Raines. Plans and property description for easements to be ready in about two weeks. Plans still within budget. Plans approved by Metropolitan Planning Commission.

Petition forms for filing for posts in city election passed out to councilmen.

Ordinance No. 17, being an ordinance relating to adoption of National Plumbing code read by John Murray. Kemler moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to adopt ordinance no. 17 for first reading. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Ordinance No. 18 being an ordinance naming streets and changing of names of streets of the City of Basehor read by John Murray. Raines moved and seconded by Worley to adopt for first reading ordinance No. 18. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
