

CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS  
COUNCIL MEETING OF APRIL 8, 1969

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl, Lester Worley and Farris Roberts.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, Delegation from New Hope Baptist Church, and John Murray, City Attorney and Bruce Browne, Engineer.

Minutes of March 4, 1969 <sup>meeting was</sup> read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Raines moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Oath of office for Mayor and all 5 councilmen given in presence of City Clerk.

Tom Pouppirt presented drawing of proposed area to be annexed to the City of Basehor. Discussed drawing and outlined for Mr. Pouppirt procedures to be followed. Procedure 1. Present petition to County Commissioners on unplatted land requesting annexation to City. County to hold hearing, then grant approval if accepted by City. Procedure 2. Have land platted and have plat accepted by County Planning Board and by City Planning Commission and City, then City may annex by ordinance.

Ordinance No. 18, being an ordinance naming streets and changing of names of streets of the City of Basehor read for second reading. Raines moved and seconded by Roberts to adopt ordinance No. 18. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mr. McAfee requested City move tube across road at south-east corner of his property. Following discussion decision held in abeyance pending receipt of Florence street lay-out plan to avoid having to move twice.

Bruce Browne presented sewer report. Plans still in Topeka for review. He recommended taking of bids on collection system on May 6, 1969. Raines moved and seconded by Worley that Engineer be authorized to advertize for bids on collection system section I, for opening May 6, 1969 at 8:00 P.M. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer opened meeting to naming of president of council. Farris Roberts nominated Bernard Eberth. Lester Worley moved nominations cease and clerk cast unanimous ballot for Bernard Eberth, Seconded by Robert Raines. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer made following appointments: Municipal Judge - William Franklin, Marshall-Cecil Swope, Treasurer - Richard C. Warden. Worley moved and seconded by Raines to confirm

appointments. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Discussed bill for weed killer in 55 gallon barrel. Purchase of same not authorized by any member of city government, therefore bill and chemical refused.

Discussed street condition. Fred Scheller granted permission to move culvert on Poplar street at his expense.

Request of Joe Daniels for license to sell 3.2 beer at grocery store presented. Roberts moved and seconded by Worley to table request until next meeting. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Meeting of May 6, 1969 set for 7:00 P.M. with request to City attorney that an ordinance be drafted re-setting meeting time from 8:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. for future meetings.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
