

City of Basehor, Kansas

Special Council Meeting

May 19, 1969

Present: Mayor Meyer, Councilmen Robert Van Tuyl, Lester Worley, Robert Raines, Bernard Eberth

Others present: Charles Newman, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney, and Bruce Browne, Engineer.

Minutes of previous meeting and treasurer's report were not read since this was not a regular monthly meeting.

Jean Rickel was present to request an explanation of how the location of the sewer project will affect the Rickel Addition. Bruce Browne explained the location and planning for the area in question. In addition Mr. Browne stated he would provide a map showing sewer locations and easements so that Council members may be able to explain to the public where the sewers are to be constructed.

Mr. Browne presented to the Council a contract and specification booklet and bid breakdown on the lump sum bid by Bethel Plumbing and Heating Co. After an explanation of the articles Mr. Browne recommended that the bid in the amount of \$159,775.85 by Bethel Plumbing and Heating Co. be accepted by the City Council.

Raines moved, seconded by Eberth, that the City of Basehor accept the low bid of the Bethel Plumbing and Heating Co. in the amount of \$159,775.85 upon the recommendation of Bruce M. Browne, Engineer, and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the contract documents with the successful bidder. Four votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.

Worley moved, seconded by Van Tuyl, that the bid breakdown submitted by the Bethel Plumbing and Heating Co. be accepted by the City of Basehor. Four votes yes; no votes opposed. Motion carried.

After sewers are completed it was explained that by ordinance a time limit will be set for property owners to hook up to sewers. Approximately thirty (30) easements will be required and will follow property lines.

John Murray stated that he had met with Mr. Thompson and had worked out tentative details for making up notes. Rate of interest may be about $5\frac{1}{2}\%$.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
