Special Council Meeting

Aug. 12, 1969

Present: Mayor Alfred Meyer, Councilmen Farris Roberts, Robert Raines, Lester Worley.

Others present: Charles Newman, City Clerk, Bruce Browne, Engineer, Thomas Pouppirt, W. T. McAfee, J. Croke, Rev. Morris Tuter, and D. McIntosh.

Mayor Meyer called the meeting to order. This being a special meeting, no minutes of previous meeting or treasurer's report was given.

Bruce Browne, in reporting on the status of the sewer project, reported that the bonding company has taken over the project and is in the process of making contacts with contractors who have the equipment and facilities to perform the work. No definite date has been established for start of construction.

Mayor Meyer stated that the budget was open for discussion and asked for comments. There being no comments, F. Roberts moved, seconded by R. Raines, that the budget be adopted as published. Three votes yes; no votes opposed.

R. Raines moved, seconded by L. Worley, that the petition submitted by Thomas Pouppirt for annexation of a plat of his property be accepted. Three votes yes; no votes opposed.

The first reading of Ordinance #25 relating to annexation of the Pouppirt property was given. F. Roberts moved, seconded by R. Raines, that Ordinance #25 be passed on the first reading. Three votes yes; no votes opposed.

R. Raines moved, seconded by F. Roberts, that an emergency be declared and Ordinance #25 be given the second and final reading. Three votes yes; no votes opposed.

R. Raines moved, seconded by F. Roberts, that Ordinance #25 be adopted on the second reading. Three votes yes; no votes opposed.

L. Worley moved, seconded by R. Raines, that the plat of the Pouppirt Addition, which was previously submitted for study by the council, be reapproved. Three votes yes; no votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer stated that the Pouppirt Plat will now be referred to the planning commission for zoning classification which will, in all probability, be zoned R-1 b.

R. Raines moved, seconded by L. Worley, that the application for a building permit submitted by the trustees of New Hope Baptist Church be approved and the city clerk be instructed to issue a permit for construction of New Hope Baptist Church. Three votes yes; no votes opposed.
