Special Council Meeting

Sept. 23, 1969

Present: Mayor Meyer, Councilmen Farris Roberts, Robert Raines, Bernard Eberth, Robert Van Tuyl, and Lester Worley.

Others present: Charles Newman, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney, and Bruce Browne, Engineer.

Mayor Meyer called the meeting to order. Minutes of the previous meeting and the treasurer's report was not given because this was a special meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the status of the sewer project. Browne updated the council on the project and stated that he felt that bids should be advertised for phase II. The council members were in agreement and Browne stated he would place the advertisement for phase II in the appropriate publication October 3, 1969, and accept bids on November 4, 1969. It would be approximately 60 days from date of advertising to the start of construction.

Mayor Meyer brought up for discussion the establishment of a definite standard for the construction of new streets within the city. Several ideas were offered, however decisions were postponed until the next regular meeting. Mayor Meyer suggested that council members study the question and submit written proposals at the next meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
