

City of Basehor, Kansas  
Council Meeting  
Sept. 2, 1969

Present: Bernard Eberth (acting mayor), Councilmen F. Roberts, R. Raines, and L. Worley

Others present: C. Newman, City Clerk, R. Warden, City Treasurer, J. Murray, City Attorney

The meeting was called to order by Bernard Eberth in the absence of Mayor Meyer who was on vacation.

Minutes of the previous meetings of Aug. 5, 1969 and Aug. 12, 1969 were read and approved.

The treasurer's report was read by R. Warden. R. Raines moved, seconded by L. Worley that the treasurer's report be accepted. Three votes yes; no votes opposed. The motion carried.

J. Murray reported that Ordinance #25 relating to the annexation of the Pouppirt Plat had been recorded and was in the process of being finalized. Murray also stated that whenever city boundaries are changed, an ordinance must be passed defining the boundaries. This may be done as a final act of the calendar year. It was also pointed out that all plats of properties should be kept on file for the city record.

F. Roberts discussed the updating of the city map by R. E. Bacon Assoc. and pointed out that the new maps will contain proper location of house numbers. This work is being done voluntarily by Bacon Assoc. and is not specifically authorized by the city.

F. Roberts reported on Joe Daniel's plans for moving his property on US 40 highway and on the locating of commercial businesses within the city. The main point of the discussion was that commercial businesses should be made to secure building permits through the city council.

Following a lengthy discussion of building permits, it was generally agreed that a review of Ordinance #13 was in order since there were some conflicts existing in the ordinance as it now exists. Acting Mayor Eberth appointed F. Roberts as chairman of the review committee and instructed all council members to review the ordinance and be prepared to offer suggestions and changes at the next meeting.

In answer to a question about weeds and trees, J. Murray stated that the property owner is responsible for cutting or maintaining same where located on city easements and parkways that are on the patrons property.

R. Raines reported that Engineer Browne had no information on the sewer project. However, Browne was urging the bonding company to get started and to show at least some movement by the last of September.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
