

CITY OF BASEHOR, KANSAS  
COUNCIL MEETING OF MARCH 4, 1969

Acting Mayor Eberth called meeting ot order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Charles Kemler, Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard C. Warden, City Treasurer, Farris Roberts, Goerge Klinkenberg, Glenn Mussett, FredSterner.

Minutes of February 4, 1969 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Raines moved and seconded by Worley to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Ordinance No. 17, being an ordinance adopting the National Plumbing Code read for second reading. Kemler moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to adopt ordinance No. 17. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Request of George Klinkenberg for permit to erect 2 car garage presented, with recommendation from planning commission that permit be issued. Raines moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to grant permit. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Request of Glenn Mussett for change of zone on lot 1, Block 1, Rickel Sub-division from R (1) b to R (2) to permit erection of duplex presented with recommendation from planning commission that this one lot be rezoned so a duplex can be constructed. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Engineer report - About ready for bids on collection system. Will call special meeting when ready to set date for bid letting.

Raines moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to reschedule April meeting to April 8 inasmuch as April 1 is election day and building being used for polling place. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Resolution presented by Bruce Browne authorizing filing of application for water pollution grant. Raines moved and seconded by Kemler to adopt resolution. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Regarding State Highway 72 door is still open to possibility of getting road put up into good condition and possibility to negotiate for funds or help in maintaining of street in future, however under city, not state system.

Sterner protested having sewer run in front of his property.

There being no furthur business the meeting adjourned.


