COUNCIL MEETING OF MAY 7, 1968

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Charles Kemler, Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present: John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, Cecil Swope, Chief of Police, John Murray, City Attorney and Fred Sterner.

Minutes of April 2, 1968 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Van Tuyl moved and seconded by Kemler to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Police report made by Cecil Swope. Eleven year olds still roaming around town at 1:00 in the mornings.

Councilman Raines suggested council investigate possibility of purchasing used radar unit for Chief of Police.

Discussion of sewer prospects followed. Prospect of funds becoming available from FHS after July 1, 1968 was the current information from FHA, providing their appropriation came thru. Basehor was at the top of the list of projects.

Discussed condition of streets in Klamm and Fetherbridge additions.

Raines moved and seconded by Kemler to stockpile chat necessary for street oiling as recommended by County Engineer and to rock immediately streets which need to be prepared for oiling, also grade streets which need grading and ditching immediately. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Street naming map brought up for discussion. Kemler moved and seconded by Raines to set May 28, 1968 as date for public hearing on street names as proposed by Planning Commission and Charles Kemler to make arrangements to have notices sent out. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

There being no furthur business the meeting adjourned.
