COUNCIL MEETING OF AUGUST 13, 1968

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present, John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney, and Fred Sterner.

Minutes of July 2, 1968 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Raines moved and seconded by Eberth to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Budget read by City clerk. Following general discussion Eberth moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to adopt budget as published. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Street naming map presented for discussion. Following limited discussion Worley moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to instruct city attorney to draw ordinance naming streets per map subject to amendment moved ~~XXXXXX~~ by Eberth and seconded by Raines to strike Petherbridge and substitute Ripley. Amendment approved 3 votes in favor 1 vote pass and 0 votes opposed. Motion approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Mayor Meyer appointed Eugene Poggemeyer and Farris Roberts to three year terms on planning commission of the City of Basehor. Raines moved and seconded by Eberth to accept appointments. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

It was brought to the attention of the council that some children had been sleeping in the Laundromat at night. Council felt that Ray Breuer, owner of the laundromat, should be informed of said occurrence. Richard Warden to so inform Ray.

Discussed street repairing and oiling. Street between grade and Junior High to be ditched and culvert placed across for drainage as soon as possible. Streets not previously oiled to be oiled this year and worst spots on previously oiled streets to be re-oiled subject to limitation of \$3,000.00 for preparation and oiling per budget.

Eberth moved and seconded by Raines that John Murray call Bob Thompson of bonding firm and ask that he meet with the council as soon as possible, preferable August 20 or 27 in reference to preparing for new meeting with general public on installation of sewers. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

There being no further business the meeting recessed on call of the Mayor.

Mayor Meyer nominated John Klinkenberg for City Clerk, Richard Warden for City Treasurer, Cecil Swope for Chief of Police, and John Murray for City Attorney. Raines moved and seconded by Eberth to approve appointments. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
