COUNCIL MEETING OF AUGUST 19, 1968

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Charles Kemler Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present; John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney, Bob Thompson and Bruce Browne.

Meeting was turned over to Bob Thompson for sewer discussion.

Mr. Thompson stated that on his own initiative he had hired Mr. Browne to examine the preliminary report of Bartlett and West and examine the site of Basehor and see if sewers could be installed within the limit of bonding indebtedness that the City of Basehor could issue, \$266,500., at present time, in as much as Bartlett and West's estimate was somewhat over amount of bonds that could be issued.

Mr. Browne reported that in his estimation, and with very few minor changes, and the elimination of all pumping stations except one in the south end, and two lagoons, that the job could be done for \$262,000.

~~XX~~ Lagoons, Plant, Force Mains, pumping station and outfall sewers subject to HEW grant and should be included in one bid letting contract. All other work should be included in one or more bid letting contracts to keep same separate from work subject to HEW grant and inspection.

Raines moved and seconded by Worley to postpone setting public hearing until further information obtained. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Kemler moved and seconded by Eberth to terminate Bartlett & West agreement for ~~E~~ Engineering service and request all his data compiled on sewers for City of Basehor and request final statement ~~for~~ for all services rendered on sewer ~~for~~ project. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
