The Mayor and the entire City Council were present for the special meeting.

The subject of the council meeting were bids for road work to be done on the western part of the city. Councilperson McKenzie discussed several bids that he had received for this road work: Meadows Construction, for \$7,800, but which excluded compaction and subgrade, essentially everything but the final grading and the compaction; H.E. Miller, without materials: \$9,038, with materials: \$13,038.

Present also were David Breuer and Steven Eberth. They discussed however that since they did not have all the equipment necessary to perform the job, that they declined to bid.

It was disclosed that Engineer Marker from Leavenworth County would bid \$35 per hour and \$45 per hour to perform the work.

MOTION: By Mr. Novak to inquire of the county as to what they would bid the grading and compaction of the streets, and agreed to commit to pay approximately \$9,000, with the efforts thereafter to coordinate the work to do the remaining street work including chip and seal. Motion passed. all ave.

Steven Eberth stated that he would do construction work and broom the streets before the county did the grading and compaction, if the Council so desired.

Donald Wilson: stated that the submersible pump in the lagoon had gone out. The consensus of the council was to get a non-submersible water pump.

Mr. Thomas Kerr: Stated that rainwater runs over his driveway and is beginning to wash out along the edge of the driveway. It was finally decided, after much discussion, that Mr. Kerr would call Mr. Rankin to see if Mr. Rankin would buy a drainage tube to be put in according to the City's current policy.

Mr. Willard Belben: He inquired as to how the water would flow in relation to his property on 156th Street. He said that if the tubes were cleaned out, the water would flow properly.

Bill Mogle: He inquired about a manhole that was supposed to be in the alley behind his house. It was the consensus of the council that the manhole should be found, and would be found when the alley is graded. It should then be raised according to anticipated specifications.

Mr. Novak made the motion to adjourn. All Aye. The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 p.m.


