COUNCIL MEETING OF OCTOBER 1, 1968

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl, and Lester Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney and Bruce Browne.

Minutes of September 3, 1968 meeting was read and approved.

John Murray read correspondence from Bartlett & West, Ben Boyer and Bruce M. Browne.

Mr. Browne presented his proposal. Approximately $7\frac{1}{2}\%$ of construction cost to be his fee for normal engineering services. Extra services such as staking, supervision full time etc. to be performed at cost plus, or $4\frac{1}{2}\%$ of construction cost for full package at the option of council.

Public meeting set tentatively for either October 10, 1968 or October 15, 1968 subject to fitting in with schedule of Bob Thompson of George K. Baum & Co. bonding firm.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Raines moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 3 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Discussed street oiling and necessity of immediate action thereon. Mayor Meyer to see what can be done.
