COUNCIL MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 3, 1968

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Charles Kemler, Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, John Murray, City Attorney, Don Johnson and Jim Pantle.

Minutes of August 13, 1968 meeting was read approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Worley moved and seconded by Kemler to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Don Johnson presented grievance.. Allen Neuman built fence to within 20 feet of Mr. Johnson's back door and is keeping horses that are reaching over said fence into Mr. Johnson's yard depriving his children of use of the yard. Mr. Neuman has told Mr. Johnson to keep his children away from the fence inasmuch as the horses will bite. City attorney was instructed to write a letter to Mr. Neuman requesting Mr. Neuman set fence back far enough that the horses not infringe on Mr. Johnson or Mr. Pantless property.

John Murray read letter sent to Bartlett and West terminating their services and reported on call he received from Harry Bartlett.

Kemler moved and seconded by Eberth to send check to Bartlett and West for \$400.00 and ask for final statement by October 1, 1968. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Eberth moved and seconded by Worley to send letter to Bruce Brown asking for his proposal as soon as possible. Approved 5 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Discussed street oiling. Oiling to be completed before next council meeting.
