COUNCIL MEETING OF NOVEMBER 12, 1968

Mayor Meyer called meeting to order. Councilmen present Bernard Eberth, Robert Raines, Robert Van Tuyl and Lester Worley.

Others present John Klinkenberg, City Clerk, Richard Warden, City Treasurer, Cecil Swope, Chief of Police, and John Murray City Attorney.

Minutes of October 1, 1968 meeting was read and approved.

Treasurers report read by Richard Warden. Raines moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to accept treasurers report as read. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Bruce Browne presented map, and estimated cost on sewers. Present estimate is for minimum \$243,500.00. Assessment on 150 ft. front approximately \$627.00 plus sewer service charge. HEW grant estimated at \$20,000.00 for treatment plant and outfall mains.

Mayor Meyer nominated George Klinkenberg to three year term on planning commission. Eberth moved and seconded by Worley. ^{To accept nomination.} Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Raines moved and seconded by Worley to have one member of city council, on a rotating basis, attend planning commission meetings. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed.

Contract between Bruce Browne and City of Basehor discussed and signed. Bob Connell to be field supervisor of Bruce Browne. Seperate bank account and seperate set of books to be set up for sewer district.

Mrs. Oroke presented grievance against Chief of Police and Mrs. Swope. Council listened and discussed same. Bob Bryan presented Dan Hawes, Lv. Col. Sheriff's backing of the cooperation our Chief of Police has provided Sheriff's Department.

Joe Jauernig present and discussed with him bill for street repairs. Raines moved and seconded by Van Tuyl to approve for payment bill totaling \$1,097.55 to Joe Jauernig. Approved 4 votes in favor 0 votes opposed. City clerk, having been served with summons of garnishment would not sign check until garnishment released.

There being no furthur business the meeting adjourned.
